2021 CALIFORNIA GRENACHE

Growing in popularity of late, Grenache is experiencing something many have been saying for years, decades, centuries. The most versatile grape by far, Grenache has been hidden in blends, playing second fiddle to other varietals. But every vintage, we strive to produce a wine that is unabashedly Grenache—how we like it. 2021 was a quality year and we benefitted from small clusters and small berries resulting in concentrated wines with depth and power. Sourced from the Dark Horse, Stagecoach and Alder Springs vineyards, the 2021 Trigger Finger is dangerous.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The 2021 Trigger Finger opens with notes of candied strawberry, pomegranate, Mission fig and fig leaf with a touch of red chard, musk and baking spices. The entry is powerful with rich black cherry and a midpalate of cola, rhubarb and spices. With grace, the wine closes with prominent tannins and a pleasing finish of freshly-steeped black tea.
